The interdisciplinary colloquium is also open to postdocs and young researchers who investigate these topics. It is supposed to encourage the exchange of subjects and methods as well as establish contacts between doctoral candidates, young researchers and renowned Eckhart scholars.

Travel grants are available. Participants of the colloquium, which precedes the conference, are also invited to take part in the congress.
